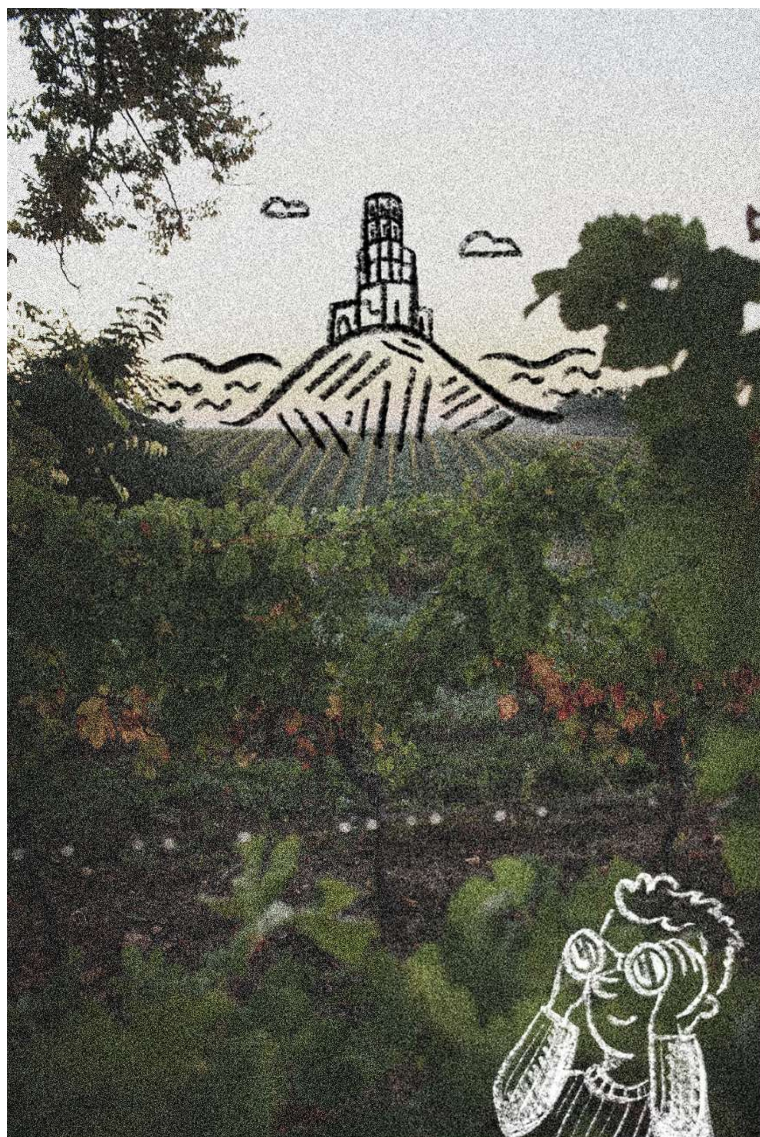

KEY DATES

For the Entre-deux-Mers vineyards



1850 : 42 000 hectares of vines ($\frac{1}{2}$ red $\frac{1}{2}$ white) : 1/3 of the total volumes of wines in Gironde

1937 : the AOC “Entre-deux-Mers” is recognized by decree for white wines only.

1957: the Entre-deux-Mers decree has been revised in order to put in place a complete control of the product in order to market authentic wines of indisputable quality

7th February 2023 : validation of the National Committee of INAO of the AOC EDM RED



Main measures of the specifications of the AOC Entre-deux-Mers Rouge



Geographical production area: the same as white wines, between the Dordogne and Garonne regions, across 133 communes

Planting density : the same as white wines: 4,500 vines per hectare: potential 5,771 eligible hectares in the production area.

Grape varieties : Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, Petit Verdot, Carmenère. As with white wines, blending is mandatory.

Vinification: Thermovinification and the use of wood chips after running off are prohibited.

Aging: No container required, marketing from January N+2 of the harvest.

Declaration of plot allocation by March 31 of the harvest.

Strengthened control with an aptitude tasting before bottling (starting with the 2025 vintage).

The Entre-deux-Mers AOC turn into red in 2023!



- Production figures for 2023, first vintage: 264 hectares for 8,464 hectoliters by 41 winegrowers (including 5 cooperative wineries), a potential of nearly one million bottles
- Special retail price target: €10 to €15 per bottle
- Priority French market.
- The red wines of Entre-deux-Mers are characterized by :

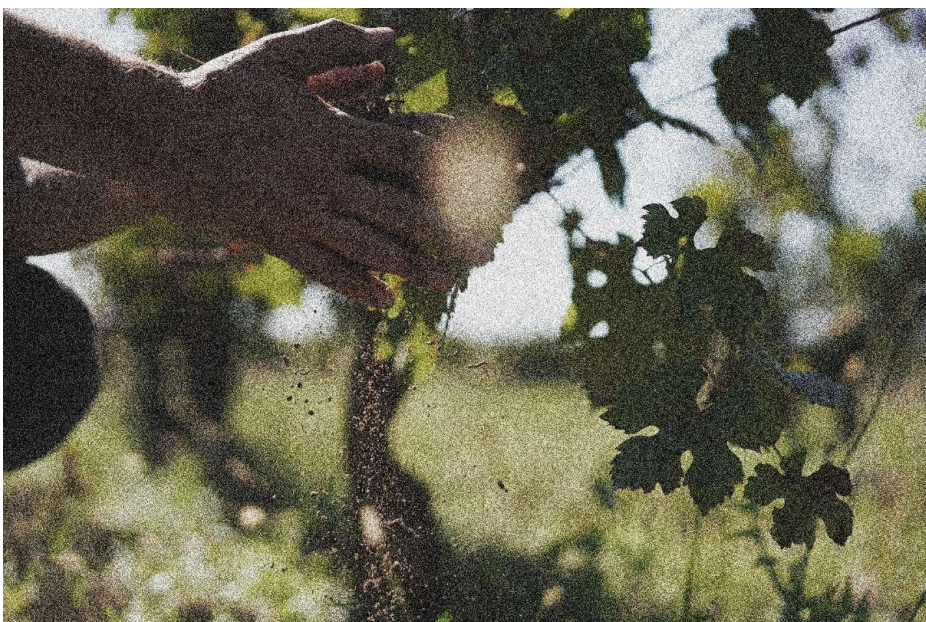
Style: Fruity with nuances of undergrowth, slightly truffled, minty, and other fruity and complex notes. The freshness of the tannins is characteristic.

A requirement: Strict specifications, early commitment of the plots, a mandatory blend, a 18-month aging period before release, and a decisive tasting to validate the cuvée. These characteristics reflect the commitment and expertise of the Entre-deux-Mers winegrowers.

2025 Key Figures

- Red EDM: 192 hectares (+39% vs. 2024)
6,704 hectoliters (+45.6% vs. 2024)
 - Average yield: 34.9 hl/ha

- 29 independent winegrowers and 8 cooperative members
